Re: Legislation Research

Following is a list of Public Acts that has utility for creation of service districts/boundaries.

The full language of these acts can be found at www.legislature.mi.gov or will be available on the USD/USB website once in operation.

1. PA 7 of 1967, Urban Cooperation Act – Allows for the creation of interlocal public agency agreements, tax sharing.
2. PA 8 of 1967, Intergovernmental Transfer of Functions and Responsibilities – Allows for the transfer of rights and responsibilities for the provision of services from one government to another.
3. PA 425 of 1984, Intergovernmental Conditional Transfer of Property by Contract – Allows the conditional transfer of property by contract between local units of governments.
4. PA 292 of 1989, Metropolitan Councils Act – Allows for planning and provision of services at the regional level.
5. PA 226 of 2003, Joint Municipal Planning Act – Allows for joint planning and the joint exercise of certain zoning powers and duties.

There are further pieces of legislation that allow for the creation of specific authorities. As necessary staff will further explore legislation for specific tasks as these are identified by the committee.
